REPORT

This Report of the Committee deals with the Action Taken by the Government on the Recommendations/Observations made in their Twelfth Report (16th Lok Sabha) regarding All India Institute of Medical Sciences - Raipur, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Jodhpur, Patna and Rishikesh which was presented to Lok Sabha on 10.08.2017.

- 2. The Action Taken Notes have since been received from the Government in respect of all the recommendations/observations contained in the aforesaid Report. Accordingly, the Statement showing the action taken by the Government on the recommendations/observations contained in the Twelfth Report (16th Lok Sabha) are given in Appendix.
- 3. The Committee in their Twelfth Report had pointed out the failure of the ministry of Health and Family Welfare regarding timely laying of the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of all these 06 AIIMS for the years 2012-13 to 2014-15 and recommended that the documents of all these 06 AIIMS should be laid within stipulated time in future.
- 4. The Committee appreciate that the Government have accepted all the recommendations of the Committee made in the said Reports and have also taken concerted steps for their implementation.
- 5. The Committee observed that out of Six AIIMS, 04 AIIMS i.e. Raipur, Bhubaneswar, Jodhpur and Rishikesh laid their documents for the year 2017-2018 almost within stipulated time period and the documents of 02 AIIMS-Bhopal and Patna for the year 2017-18 were laid on the Table of the House with delay of 06 months. Further, the Annual Report and Audited Accounts of the AIIMS, Rishikesh for the year 2018-19 have laid on the Table of the House on 10.02.2020 with delay of 1 month and 10 days. However, the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of other 05 AIIMS i.e. Raipur*, Bhubaneswar*, Jodhpur*, Bhopal and Patna not been laid yet. The documents of all the 06 AIIMS are required to be laid with in stipulated time period. The Committee, therefore, recommend to evolve an effective mechanism ensuring that the documents of each of the organisation are laid within the stipulated time frame in future. The Committee would like to be informed that steps taken by the Ministry in this regard.

STATEMENT SHOWING ACTION TAKEN BY GOVERNMENT ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS/OBSERVATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE CONTAINED IN THEIR TWELFTH REPORT (16TH LOK SABHA)

All India Institute of Medical Sciences – Raipur, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Jodhpur, Patna and Rishikesh

Recommendation (Paragraph No. 16 to 18)

- 16. The Committee have time and again emphasized that both the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of an Organisation should be laid on the Table of the House simultaneously so as to enable the Members of Parliament to get a complete picture of the working and activities of the Organisation. However, the Committee are disappointed to note that the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has failed to comply with the specific recommendations of the Committee in laying the requisite documents of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences Raipur, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Jodhpur, Patna and Rishikesh before Parliament during the years 2012-13 to 2014-2015. The committee note that the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts for the years 2012-13 and 2013-14 were delayed ranging from 07 to 19 months. The Committee also note that the reasons for delay was mainly that the five Institutes were newly established, without proper infrastructure, man power, lack of Hindi translator, delay in appointment of Auditor, delay submission of Audit Report from C&AG and also lack of experience in laying of the requisite documents on the Table of the House.
- 17. The Committee also note that the work related to laying of the Annual Report and Audited Accounts for the year 2014-15 had been finished and Institution Board (IB) approval was taken by the end of December, but the requisite documents could not be laid in Winter Session. Further, the documents for the year 2014-15 were laid in Budget Session, 2016 with delays of 2½ months. The Institutes also assured to streamline the process of laying of documents in stipulated time in near future. The Committee appreciates the efforts taken by the Ministry/Institutes to lay the Annual Report and Audited Accounts for the year 2015-16 within the stipulated time period.
- 18. The Committee also impress upon the Ministry that if for any reasons, the Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of the Institutes could not be laid on the Table of the House within the stipulated time; a statement explaining the reasons as to why the requisite documents could not be laid within prescribed period should be laid strictly within 30 days as recommended by the Committee in its earlier Report.

The Annual Reports and Audited Accounts of six new AIIMS for the year 2017-18 have been laid on the Table of the House, as follows;
