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- (e) Screening of video films depicting important activities of the Department at various Public Awareness Programmes organised at various places.
- (f) Arranging Open-house programmes for the benefit of the people in the neighbourhood of the concerned R&D Units.
- (e) and (f) At present, India does not have any bilateral agreement for peaceful uses of atomic energy with any of the SAARC countries. However, under the IAEA Technical Cooperation programme, India has collaborated in the peaceful applications of Atomic Energy with Bangladesh and Sri Lanka. Collaboration has taken place in various areas including radioisotopes, Nuclear Technology to improve Agricultural Products, food irradiation, Radiation Protection etc. involving not only exchange and training of scientists but also supply of equipment.
