(a) Centrally Sponsored 'Integrated Cereals Development Programme in Rice Based Cropping Systems Areas' (ICDF-Rice) is being implemented in sixteen States and Union Territory of Pondicherry since 1994-95. However, the erstwhile scheme of Integrated Programme for Rice Development (IPRD) was implemented in the country from 1990-91 to 1993-94.
