**CONSTRUCTION OF JIRIBAM-IMPHAL RAIL LINE**

**2465. DR. THOKCHOM MEINYA:**

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the construction of Jiribam-Tupul-Imphal Railway Line has been completed;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the reasons for not starting the train services on this line; and**
- (d) whether stations at Tupul and Imphal are ready and if so, the details thereof?**

**(a) to (c): Works of Jiribam-Tupul-Imphal new railway line have been taken up. The project is not yet completed. Jiribam-Vangaichungpao (11.80 km) section is completed and commissioned. Works have been taken up in remaining length. Passenger train service has been started in Jiribam-Vangaichungpao section in March, 2017 and it will be extended upto Imphal after completion of work and commissioning of the section.**

**(d): Construction work of Tupul station has been taken up. For Imphal station, land has been acquired and General Agreement Drawings (GAD) has been approved to start the work.**

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
