**(a) to (d): Yes, Madam. Airports Authority of India (AAI) has undertaken the construction of new integrated terminal building with peak hour capacity of 2900 passengers, construction of Apron for parking 10 code-C aircraft, associated taxiways, Isolation Bay, GSE Area and associated works and Air Traffic Control Tower at Tiruchi Airport at a cost of Rs. 951.28 Crores. The probable date of completion of new terminal building is in November, 2021 and is to be functional in December, 2021.**

**(e): AAI has earmarked Rs. 14.0 Crore for the project in the current financial year and has released Rs. 2.23 Crore during current financial year.**
