3754. SHRI LAXMAN GILUWA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

- (a) whether the Government proposes/contemplating to convert National Highways (NHs) 75E into four lane;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor and the reaction of the Government thereto?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) : As per the extant policy of this Ministry, National Highways having traffic more than 10,000 PCUs per day are to be 4 – laned based on the outcome of Detailed Project Report (DPR). Stretches of NH-75E are in various stages of progress for development including their 2/4-laning. About 103 km. of NH-75E in the State of Madhya Pradesh is under implementation for 4-laning.
