(a) & (b): The Electronic Media Monitoring Centre (EMMC) under the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, monitors compliance by the television channels to the Programme and Advertising Codes prescribed under Cable Television Networks (Regulation) Act, 1995 and rules framed thereunder. The EMMC was established in the year 2008.

(c): The monitoring team is given fees ranging from Rs.28,000/- to Rs.49,000/- (approx) per month.
