- (e) the rank at which India is placed among these Nations?

- (a) and (b): The membership of the G-20 comprises of 19 developed and developing countries and the European Union. These 19 member countries are; Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Turkey, United Kingdom, and United States.
- (c) to (e): No, Sir. G20 does not rank the countries. However, according to World Banks' Gross Domestic Product (GDP) 2017 rankings for all countries, India ranks sixth among G20 countries.
