Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has approved a new ambitious scheme to improve the quality of technical education institutions located in various States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has any plan for improvement and quality upgradation of technical institution located in Bundelkhand; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The Govt. of India has approved the third phase of Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP-III), with assistance from the World Bank, for improving the overall quality of Technical Education in 19 focus states (7 low income states, 3 hill states, 8 north eastern region states and Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands) with an outlay of Rs. 2660 crore. The programme has commenced from April 2017 and has implementation period of 3 years. The main objective the project is to enhance quality and equity in selected engineering education institutes and improve the efficiency of the engineering education system in Focus States. Three Govt./Govt. aided Engineering Institutions from Bundelkhand have been selected under TEQIP-III, the details of which are as follows:

- i. Institute of Engineering & Technology, Bundelkhand University, Jhansi
- ii. Bundelkhand Institute of Engineering & Technology, Jhansi
- iii. Rajkiya Engineering College, Banda
