- (a) whether ISRO has roped in three partners to help it assemble 27 satellites at a quick pace over the next three years;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether ISRO expects 27 spacecrafts ready by July, 2021; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof?**

- (a) Yes Madam, it is for 21 Units.**
- (b) The memorandum of understanding is to carry out Assembly, Integration and Testing (AIT) of I-1000 Kg to I-3000 Kg class communication/ remote sensing/ navigation satellites.**
- (c) & (d)**

It is for 21 units for all the three parties together. One unit is equal to one number of I-1000 Kg satellite. These 21 units will be completed by July, 2021. The satellites will be decided with respect to their delivery schedules.
