(a) According to the latest statistics, India is ranked among the top 10 countries of the world in investment towards Research and Development (R&D) in terms of US\$ Purchasing Power Parity (PPP).

(b) The Government has been constantly engaged in the promotion and growth of scientific research in the country through various measures with successive increase in plan allocations for scientific departments. As a consequence, India's national expenditure on R&D has been increasing consistently over the years and tripled in a decade from Rs 24,117.24 crores in 2004-05 to Rs 85,326.10 crores in 2014-15. It is estimated to be Rs 94,516.45 crores in 2015-16 and Rs 1,04,864.03 crores in 2016-17.
