Details regarding NRDWP

731. KUMARI SUSHMITA DEV:

Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated, funds released and funds utilised under the National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) from the year 2014 to 2018, State-wise and year-wise;
- (b) the details of the percentage of the population in the State of Assam that does not have access to safe and portable drinking water from the year 2014 to 2018; and
- (c) the details of the percentage of Government schools and AnganwadiCentres with access to safe and portable drinking water under the National Rural Drinking Water Programme from the year 2014 to 2018, State-wise and year-wise ?

ANSWER

- (a) The State-wise and year-wise details of funds allocated, released and utilised under the National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) from the year 2014 to 2018 are at **Annexure-I**.
- (b) This Ministry assists the States for improving the coverage of drinking water supply in rural areas only. As per the information provided by State of Assam on the online Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of the Ministry, the details of the rural population not having access to safe and portable drinking water from the year 2014 to 2018 are as under:-

- (c) The Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation provides technical and financial assistance to States under the National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP) for supplementing their efforts in providing drinking water supply in rural areas including schools. The assistance under the programme includes provision of drinking water supply in schools which were constructed prior to 2007. For schools constructed post 2007, facility specific to school is funded through Ministry of HRD. States have been advised to provide facilities in the vicinity of school / AnganwadiCentrespremises while planning / executing NRDWP water supply schemes.

As informed by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of School Education and Literacy, state-wise details of percentage of drinking water facilities and functional drinking water facilities in Government Schools is given at **Annexure-II**.
