**RELEASE OF FUNDS UNDER PMKSY**

874. KUMARI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government provides any technical and financial assistance to States to encourage sustainable development and efficient management of water resources through various schemes/programmes and if so, the details thereof ;
- (b) the main components and objectives of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) and the total outlay for this Yojana;
- (c) whether all the States are covered under the PMKSY and if so, the details of medium/major irrigation projects identified in consultation with States alongwith irrigation potential of these projects ;
- (d) the funds released under the yojana during the last three years and the current financial year as on 31.12.2018, State/project-wise; and
- (e) the quantum of Central Assistance (CA) released under various components of PMKSY especially AIBP, CAD and DRIP-II for the State of Karnataka during the last three years and the current year ?

**ANSWER**

(a) to c) The Water Resources Projects are planned, funded, executed and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priority. In order to supplement their efforts, Government of India provides technical and financial assistance to State Governments to encourage sustainable development and efficient management of water resources through various schemes and programmes such as Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY).

PMKSY was launched during the year 2015-16, with an aim to enhance physical access of water on farm and expand cultivable area under assured irrigation, improve on-farm water use efficiency, introduce sustainable water conservation practices, etc. PMKSY has various components viz. Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP), PMKSY – Har Khet Ko Pani (HKKP) including

Command Area Development (CAD), Surface-Minor Irrigation (SMI) and Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of Water Bodies [Implemented by MoWR, RD & GR], PMKSY - Per Drop More Crop (PDMC) [Implemented by Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare] and PMKSY - Watershed Development (WD) [Implemented by Department of Land Resources]. PMKSY has been approved for implementation across the country with an outlay of Rs. 50,000 crore during 2015-2016 to 2019-2020

Further during 2016-17, ninety-nine (99) on-going Major/Medium irrigation projects under PMKSY - (AIBP), having ultimate irrigation potential of 76.03 lakh ha. and balance estimated cost of Rs.77595 cr. [ Central assistance (CA) component of 31342 Cr] have been prioritized in consultation with States, for completion in phases up to December, 2019 along with their Command Area Development & Water Management (CADWM) works. Funding mechanism through NABARD has been approved by the Government for both Central and State Share.

All States are eligible for funding under various components of PMKSY subject to fulfilment of criterion laid down in the guidelines of the respective components. However, under AIBP/CAD component, funds are being provided to only 99 prioritised projects which are situated in 18 states.

(d) & e) The State wise details of the CA released under various components of PMKSY including that for Karnataka during last three years and current year are at **Annexure**.

Under World bank assisted DRIP, Karnataka Water Resources Department has spent Rs.326.93 crore from the year 2015-16 on words. The World Bank share is Rs.261.54 crore.
