**Assessment of Drinking and Sanitation Schemes**

**†919. SHRI MANSHANKAR NINAMA:**

Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has recently made any assessment to ascertain the status of implementation of drinking water and sanitation schemes;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has received any complaints regarding irregularities in the implementation of drinking water and sanitation schemes in the States/UTs;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the remedial measures adopted by the Government in this regard; and
- (e) the details of the funds allocated and utilized under these schemes during the last three years and the current year, State-wise?

**ANSWER**

**(SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)**

- (a) & (b) Status of implementation of Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) [SBM(G)] and National Rural Drinking Water Programme [NRDWP] is regularly assessed by the Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation through field visits by the Ministry's officials, various reports available on online Integrated Management Information System (IMIS), review meetings and Video conferencing with the States/UTs, multi-level decentralized verification process by the districts and States, and third party surveys. Sanitation coverage which was 38.7% as on 2.10.2014 has increased to more than 98% and 27 States, 601 districts, 5,928 Blocks, 2,46,093 GPs and 5,50,038 villages have been declared Open Defecation Free (ODF).

The Ministry has done an independent assessment of completed Piped Water Supply Schemes two years back in 5,600 villages regarding their functionality status. The findings of the assessment revealed that 78.19% Piped Water Supply schemes were functional.

- (c)& (d) Drinking Water and Sanitation are State subjects and hence the responsibility for implementation of the programme lies with the States. Government of India provides technical and financial support to supplement the efforts of the State Governments. Complaints, if any, received are forwarded to the respective State Governments for appropriate corrective measures.
- (e) The State-wise details of the funds allocated and utilized under NRDWP during the last three years and the current year, are at Annexure-I. SBM(G) is a demand driven programme, hence fixed State-wise allocation of funds is not made under this programme. However, State/UT-wise details of Central share funds released and utilised by the States/UTs during the last 3 years and the current year are given at Annexure-II.
