MSME EXPORT

1196. SHRI ANTO ANTONY:

Will the Minister of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any statistics regarding the revenue generated through Export by MSME sector;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the details of the revenue generated during the past six years, year-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has noticed the decline in export revenue by the MSME sector; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government to enhance export by MSMEs?

(a) to (c): As per the information received from Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence & Statistics (DGCI&S), the revenue of Export of specified MSME related products are as follows:

(d): Government of India has taken several measures to enhance the exports by Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs). These include efforts made under Make in India Programme, Promotion of Ease of Doing Business, improved availability of credit through MUDRA, Stand up India, schemes such as 'Merchandise Exports from India Scheme' (MEIS) for incentivising export of specified goods to specified markets and 'Service Exports from India Scheme' (SEIS) for increasing exports of notified services from India, 2 percent interest subvention for all GST registered MSMEs on fresh or incremental loans and increase in interest rebate from 3 percent to 5 percent for exporters who receive pre-shipment and post-shipment loans.
