- (a) whether the Government has taken any steps to set up National Testing Agency (NTA) to conduct test for admission in higher education institutes;
- (b) if so, the time by which this work is likely to be completed along with the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the time by which this work is likely to be completed?

(a) to (c): In pursuance of the Budget Announcement 2017-18, the Government has established National Testing Agency (NTA) as an autonomous and self-sustained premier testing organization to conduct those entrance examinations which were hitherto being conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). NTA is fully functional with necessary infrastructure and manpower in place. It has successfully conducted UGC (NET) in December, 2018, JEE (MAIN), CMAT and GPAT in January, 2019.
