**Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Swadesh Darshan - Integrated Development of Theme-based Tourist Circuits and Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) had been launched by the Union Government for the development of tourism infrastructure in the country and if so, the details and the facts thereof along with the aims and objectives of the said schemes;**
- (b) the number of projects identified under the Swadesh Darshan and the funds sanctioned in this regard along with the religious sites identified under the PRASHAD scheme and the funds sanctioned for these sites, State/UT-wise;**
- (c) whether the Government has sanctioned four new projects under the Swadesh Darshan, PRASHAD and Tourism Infrastructure Development Schemes for Meghalaya, Gujarat,**

**Uttar Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra and Bundelkhand and if so, the details thereof;**

- (d) the funds allocated to these States under these schemes for the development of tourism during the last three years; and**
- (e) whether the Government proposes to include more projects/sites under these schemes and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

### **ANSWER**

**(a) to (e): The Ministry of Tourism has launched Swadesh Darshan and PRASHAD Schemes in 2014-15 for development of tourism infrastructure in the country with following objectives:**

- To position tourism as a major engine of economic growth and job creation**
- Develop circuits/destinations having tourist potential in a planned and prioritized manner**
- Promote cultural and heritage value of the country to generate livelihoods in the identified regions**
- Enhancing the tourist attractiveness in a sustainable manner by developing world class infrastructure in the circuit /destinations**
- Follow community based development and pro-poor tourism approach**
- Development of tourist facilitation services to enhance visitor experience/satisfaction.**

**The state-wise details of projects sanctioned along with funds allocated under both the schemes are given in the Annexure.**

**Under PRASHAD scheme, 41 sites have been identified for development covering 25 states namely Amaravati and Srisailam (Andhra Pradesh), Kamakhya (Assam), Parasuram Kund (Lohit District, Arunachal Pradesh), Patna and Gaya (Bihar), Balmeshwari Devi Temple (Rajnandgaon, Chhattisgarh), Dwarka and Somnath (Gujarat), Gurudwara Nada Saheb, Panchkula (Haryana), Maa Chintpurni (Una, Himachal Pradesh), Hazratbal and Katra (Jammu & Kashmir), Deogarh and Parasnath (Jharkhand), Chamundeshwari**

**Devi, Mysuru (Karnataka), Guruvayoor, St. Thomas International Shrine, (Malayattoor), Cheraman Juma Mosque (Thrissur, Kerala), Omkareshwar and Amarkantak (Madhya Pradesh), Babedpara, West Jaintia Hills and Sohra (Meghalaya), Aizwal (Mizoram), Kohima and Mokokchung Districts (Nagaland), Trimbakeshwar (Maharashtra), Puri (Odisha), Amritsar (Punjab), Ajmer (Rajasthan), Kanchipuram and Vellankani (Tamil Nadu), Tripura Sundari (Tripura), Varanasi, and Mathura (Uttar Pradesh), Badrinath, Kedarnath, Gangotri and Yamunotri (Uttarakhand) and Belur (West Bengal).**

**The projects under the scheme are identified for development in consultation with the State Governments/ UT Administrations and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable detailed project reports, adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier. Submission of projects by the State Government/UT Administrations under the scheme is a continuous process.**
