DOCUMENTATION OF ANCIENT MANUSCRIPTS

1351. SHRI B. SENGUTTUVAN:

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Mission for Documentation of Ancient Manuscripts has completed its tenure and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has been able to document valuable ancient manuscripts from all Indian languages including Tamil, Malayalam and Sanskrit and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether valuable manuscripts containing the practice of Siddha and Ayurvedic Medicines have also been documented and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) The National Mission for Manuscripts (NMM) was established in 2003 covering the 10th plan period i.e. up to 31-03-2007. The tenure of the Mission was extended by the Ministry of Culture twice over the 11th and 12th plan periods i.e. up to 31-03-2017. At present, tenure of the Mission stands extended till 31-03-2020.
- (b) The Mission documents Indian Manuscripts in all Indian languages. Till date it has documented 43.16 lakhs Manuscripts including Manuscripts in Tamil, Malayalam and Sanskrit languages. The details are as under:
 - i. Number of Tamil Manuscripts documented 139552
 - ii. Number of Malayalam Manuscripts documented 120641
 - Number of Sanskrit Manuscripts documented 1702754
- (c) Yes Madam, National Mission for Manuscripts has documented 183210 Manuscripts on Siddha and Ayurvedic Medicines so far.
