SKILL DEVELOPMENT IN MAHARASHTRA

Will the MINISTER of SKILL DEVELOPMENT and ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has sanctioned any grants/funds for any city of Maharashtra under the Skill Development Programme from the year 2015 till date;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) the district-wise number of youths provided training in the said State under the Skill Development Programme from the years 2015 to 2017?

ANSWER

MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) to (c) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship is implementing a flagship scheme known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 2016-20 with an objective to provide skilling to one crore people under Short Term Training (STT), Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and Special Project (SP) across the country including State of Maharashtra for four years i.e. 2016-2020 with an outlay of 12,000 crore. PMKVY 2016-20 has two components known as Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) being implemented by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) being implemented by State Skill Development Missions of the States/ UTs popularly known as State- Engagement Component of PMKVY (2016-20).

Under CSCM component of PMKVY 2016-20, there is no provision of State/district -wise allocation of funds. Under this component, funds are being released to NSDC which are subsequently released by NSDC on reimbursement basis at various stages of training (commencement of the training after validation, successful certification and placement) to the empanelled training providers and centres. Further, under CSSM component of PMKVY 2016-20, 25% of the funds and corresponding physical targets of PMKVY 2016-20 has been allocated to the States for the implementation of scheme through State Skill Development Missions. Under this component, after evaluation of proposal received from Maharashtra State Skill Development Society (MSSDS), Government of Maharashtra, Ministry has given in-principle approval of a total target of 1,67,127 candidates and corresponding financial allocation of Rs. 257.32 Cr. for FY 2017-20. Out of which, as on 24.01.2019, funds amounting to Rs. 85.77 Cr. has been already disbursed to State Government for implementation of the CSSM component of PMKVY across the State.
