- (c) whether the said portal is a centralised electronic platform for quicker processing of loans under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM);
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether it is envisioned to uplift urban poor folks by enhancing sustainable livelihood opportunities through skill development; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Yes, Madam,

The Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs has launched an online web portal namely, Portal for Affordable Credit and Interest Subvention Access (PAiSA), on 26th November, 2018 to smoothen the process of

- payment of interest subvention to individuals/ groups/ Self Help Groups for setting up gainful self-employment ventures or micro-enterprises under Self Employment Programme (SEP) component of the Deendayal **National Urban Livelihoods** Antyodaya Yojana -Mission (DAY-NULM). PAiSA Portal aggregates banks, States and Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) on a single platform. facilitating real time exchange of information, and provides a simple mechanism to process interest subvention on monthly basis through **Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode.**
- (e) & (f) The Employment through Skill Training & Placement (EST&P) component of the Mission aims to provide skills to the urban poor to increase their income through structured and market-oriented certified courses that can provide wage employment and/or self-employment opportunities which will eventually lead to better living standards and alleviation of urban poverty on a sustainable basis. So far under DAY-NULM, 8,79,767 number of urban poor have been skill trained & certified and 4,71,846 are placed.
