Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** be pleased to state: वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्री

- (a) whether a panel of senior bureaucrats had reviewed recommendations of a task force on e-Commerce and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government is making efforts to hammer out consensus on the e-Commerce Policy and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether a task force set up for the e-Commerce had drawn criticism for its suggestions, including making necessary policy changes to enable founders of domestic e-Commerce companies to have a control even if their share holding is small, allowing foreign direct investment in e-Retailers that hold inventory of all locally produced items and asking firms to store data locally within two years and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether curbs on deep discounts and bulk purchases of certain items, etc. have also been sticking points with some stakeholders and if so, the details thereof?
