Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any data sharing policy with different State Governments on Sustainable Development Goals;

(b) if so, the details thereof and whether the committee has recommended changes in the policy of data sharing and if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government proposes to frame a policy to share data, doing away with the existing means that would centralize database on different variables with cross bifurcation of socio-religious groups; and

(d) if so, the details thereof including the mode of dissemination of data?
