(a) & (b): Defence Public Sector Undertakings (DPSUs) under Department of defence Production (DDP) sign an Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) every year, which is a mutually negotiated agreement between the management of the Defence Production Sector Undertakings and the Government of India. Under this agreement, the DPSUs undertake to achieve the targets set in the agreement at the beginning of the year. MoU is a major policy initiative of the Government of India to evaluate the condition and feasibility of CPSEs & facilitates the empowerment and enhancing the performance levels of the DPSUs.

The performance of DPSUs based on MoU has been evaluated for 2017-18 and Five (05) DPSUs & Four (04) DPSUs have been rated as “Excellent” and “Very Good” respectively.
