Title: Regarding welfare schemes for old age persons.

SHRIMATI P.K. SHREEMATHI TEACHER (KANNUR): Hon. Speaker Madam, there are nearly 104 million elderly persons in our country and their number is increasing steadily. It was found that 71 per cent of elderly population resides in rural areas while 29 per cent in urban areas. Of these 104 million elderly people, it was found that more than 51 million of them live below poverty line. We need immediate intervention by the Central and the State Governments. The issue of elder abuse highlights a national shame. It requires both

introspection and action from society at large. Many elderly persons are being subjected to

abuse within their own families by their own sons and daughters.

Madam Speaker, with the changing family patterns and younger people migrating to cities in search of work, a large number of elders are being left alone at their old age. In urban areas, adults find themselves so pre-occupied with work and the stress of city life that they leave elder persons unattended at home.

Another cause for worry is that the number of homeless elderly is also increasing. ...(Interruptions)
