(2) Further discussion on the atrocities on Harijans and Adivasis in different parts of the country.

To be taken up immediately after the Question Hour on Friday, the 12th August, 1988 till 3.30 P.M. Debate to conclude on 12th August, 1988 and the Minister may reply on Tuesday, the 16th August, 1988.

4. The Committee further recommend that the sittings of Lok Sabha fixed on Thursday, the 25th and Friday, the 26th August, 1988 may be cancelled. In order to make up for the lost time, the House may sit during lunch hour and if necessary sit late also from Tuesday, the 9th August, 1988 till the end of the current session.
