The Business Advisory Committee held a sitting on Friday, the 14th August, 1987.

2. The Committee recommend the allocation of time to the following items of business as shown against each:—

4. The Punjab State Legislature (Delegation of Powers) Bill, 1987, as passed by Rajya Sabha. 1 hour
