

BUSINESS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

(Eighth Lok Sabha)

(SIXTY-SIXTH REPORT)

(Presented on 1-3-1989)

The Business Advisory Committee held a sitting on Wednesday, the 1st March, 1989.

2. The Committee recommend allocation of 15 hours to the General Discussion on the General Budget for 1989-90.

3. The Committee also recommend that discussion on the Government Motion regarding the Report of the Commission on Centre-State relations for which 5 hours have already been allotted by the House, may be held on Thursday, the 9th March, 1989.

4. The Committee further recommend that the sittings of Lok Sabha fixed on Monday, the 20th March, 1989, Tuesday, the 21st March, 1989 and Thursday, the 23rd March 1989 may be cancelled.

5. The Committee further recommend that in order to provide time for completion of urgent financial business:—

- (i) Half-an-hour discussions, discussions under Rule 193 or discussions on No-Day-Yet-Named Motions might be taken up at 6 P.M.; and
- (ii) normally not more than one half-an-hour discussion might be put down in a week and discussions under Rule 193 or No-Day-Yet-Named Motions might be allowed only on very important subjects till the disposal of financial business.
