- (5) Discussion on the 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Reports of the Commission for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and 28th Report of the Commissioner for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- (6) The Employees State Insurance Corporation (Amendment) Bill, 1989, as passed by Rajya Sabha.
