- (4) Discussion and Voting on the Supplementary Demands for Grants (Assam) for 1990-91.
- (5) Discussion on the Resolution regarding President's Rule in 2 hours the State of Goa.
- (6) Discussion and Voting on the Supplementary Demands for 3 hours Grants (General) 1990-91.
- (7) Discussion and Voting on the Supplementary Demands for 3½ hours Grants (Jammu & Kashmir) for 1990-91.
- 3. The Committee also recommend that the sittings of the House fixed for 31 December, 1990 and 1 January, 1991 be cancelled and the House might sit on 9 and 10 January, 1991.
- 4. The Committee further recommend that questions listed for 31 December, 1990 and 1 January, 1991 may be put down for answer on 9 and 10 January, 1991, respectively, and to give effect to this recommendation the relevant rule may be suspended.
- 5. The Committee also recommend that discussion under rule 193 on the risc in prices of essential commodities may be held on Wednesday, the 2nd January, 1991 at 4 p.m.
