## EIGHTEENTH REPORT

(Presented on 7-1-1991)

The Business Advisory Committee held a sitting on Monday, the 7th January, 1991.

- 2. Reconsidering the earlier decision of the House, the Committee recommend the allocation of revised time to the following items of business as shown against each:—
  - (1) Discussion on the Resolution regarding President's Rule in the State of Assam.

(2) Discussion and Voting on the Supplementary Demands for Grants (Assam) for 1990-91.

(3) Discussion and Voting on the Supplementary Demands for Grants (General) 1990-91.

(4) Discussion and Voting on the Supplementary Demands for Grants (Jammu & Kashmir) for 1990-91. 2 hours.

- 5. The Committee also recommend that subject to the availability of time, the Discussions under Rule 193 may be held in respect of the matters in the following order during the Current Session:
