## FIRST REPORT

(Presented on 29-1-1980)

The Business Advisory Committee held a sitting on Tuesday, 29 January, 1980.

2. The Committee recommend the allocation of time to the following items of business as shown against them:—

- (7) Discussion on the Resolution seeking approval of the Proclamation issued by the President on the 12th December, 1979 under article 356 of the Constitution in relation to the State of Assam.

4. The Committee further recommend that discussion under Rule 193 on recent political developments in Afghanistan and the resultant escalation of tension in the neighbourhood may be held on Friday, 1 February, 1980 at 6 P.M. for one hour.

5. The Committee further recommend that in order to provide sufficient time for completion of the above items of business, the House may sit during lunch hour also from 30 January to 2 February, 1980.
