(i) Need for early Establishment of Uttar Orissa Central University in Orissa

DR. KARTIKESWAR PATRA (Balasore): Sir, I have brought to the notice of the Government, the fact regarding establishment of Uttar Orissa Central University at a suitable place in Orissa, covering the districts of Balasore, Bhadrak, Mayurbhanj and Keonjhar in Orissa. The Utkal University, which has the largest number of colleges in the country, is facing much difficulties of workload. Moreover, these districts are facing the difficulty of long distances to be covered.

I would request the hon. Minister of Human Resource Development to take necessary steps immediately for the establishment of the Uttar Orissa Central University.

(ii) Need to Provide relief to the people affected by floods in Ghaghar River in Rajasthan

SHRI BIRBAL (Ganganagar): This year monsoon has been very good all over India. In Rajasthan Ghaghar river, in which water from Haryana and Rajasthan also flows, passes through the middle of Town and Junction of Hanumangarh town which happens to be my constituency. The town always faces a danger of flood as the river passes through the residential areas.

For the last several years, standing crops on thousands of acres of land of our farmers is damaged every year due to breaches in dams on the river, constructed by the local farmers but the water did not enter into the town till last year.

But Sir, as the repair work of several years old embankments of Ghaghar river was not undertaken, the heavy flow of river water caused havoc in the residential areas of Hanumangarh junction.
