(x) **Financial Assistance to Tamilnadu to rehabilitate flood-affected people.**

SHRI S.T.K. JAKKAYAN (Periyakulam) : The unseasonal torrential rain throughout Tamil Nadu from February 5th to 15th has left a trail of destruction. 110 people have lost their lives; 16,300 heads of cattle are dead. 43 lakhs of people in 5893 villages are affected. The crops on 2.2 lakh acres have been uprooted, 3 27 lakh huts have been destroyed. 3183 irrigation works, 611 bridges, 1,110 school and hospital buildings have been damaged. 7000 kms. of roads are under repair. 319 kms. of roads have been completely destroyed. The districts of Tiruchirpalli, South Arcot, Pudukottai, Ramanathapuram, Tirunelveli North Arcot and Chengleput are reeling under the flood havoc. This has been preceded by heavy rains for three days in December and the vast areas of the State are submerged in water. The Central Government has so far given Rs. 15 crores as flood relief assistance. But the State Government has spent Rs. 37 54 crores. After sending detailed reports about the floods, the State Government has asked for a sum of Rs. 128 crores. It is requested that the Centre may sanction immediately flood relief assistance to the tune of Rs. 128 crores and rehabilitate the flood-affected people of Tamilnadu.
