telephonic talks; and whenever he comes here he meets, me and we have had personal discussion on these matters with him.

As far as the bomb explosion is concerned, it is true that it has happend. But I did not mention in my Statement the details of all the bomb explosions that have taken place. As far as the tourist traffic is concerned, as far as air traffic is concerned, at has not been affected. But the traffic which passes through Punjab has been definitely affected and to that extent the tourists in Kashmir are less this year as compared to last year.
