Statement

Presumably, the Honourable Member refers to Defence lands. There is no scheme, as such, for allotment or selling of agricultural and residential lands in big cities. However, under the existing policy of the Government, disposal of vacant Defence lands inside cantonments is regulated in the following manner:—

1. *Outside Civil areas*

(i) By sale of alternative residential plots to such grantees/lessees whose sites held on resumable tenures have been taken back for Defence purposes.

(ii) By grant of lease to charitable and educational institutions run by registered bodies or public trusts.
