राष्ट्रीयकृत बैंकों की कई शाखायें हैं। लखासराय स्थित स्टेट बैंक में टेजरी का काम अत्यधिक होने के कारण ये बैंक तो ग्रति व्यवस्त बैंक बन चके हैं। उपरोक्त परिस्थिति में लखीसराय में कम से कम दो ग्रौर राष्ट्रीयकृत बैंक की शाखायें खोलना ग्रनिवार्य है, जिसमें एक पंजाब नेशनल बैंक एवं दूसरा यना-इटेड कामशियल बैंक की शाखा खोली जा सकती हैं। ग्रतएव लखीसराय का व्यापारिक महत्ता एवं व्यवस्तता को देखते हुए अनुरोध है कि यहां उपरोक्त दोनों बैंकों की शाखायें भारत सरकार द्वारा खोलने की अनुमति प्रदान की जाए। बैंक की नई शाखाग्रों के ग्रभाव में इस क्षेत्र का ग्राधिक विकास ग्रवरु हो गया है ग्रीर इससे पूरे ग्रन्मंडल के तकरीबन लाखों लोग प्रभावित हैं। ग्राज से 5-6 वर्ष पहले ग्रन्मंडल की स्थापना हुई, ग्रतः सरकारी कार्यालयों, ग्रस्पतालों, कचहरी के कार्यों में बढोतरी हो गई है। जब 30-40 वर्ष पहले दो राष्ट्रीयकृत बैंकों स्टेट बैंक ग्रौर सैंन्ट्रल बैंकों की स्थाना हुई थी, उस समय लखीसराय ग्रनमंडल नहीं था ग्रौर न इतनी स्राबादी थी।

ग्रतः सरकार का ध्यान इस ग्रोर श्राः ष्ट करती हं ग्रौर निवेदन है कि भ्रविलम्ब ग्रौर बैंकों की स्थापना की जाए।

(v) BANK LOAN FACILITY TO FARMERS OF JALLA AREA NEAR PATNA IN BIHAR.

श्री रामावतार शास्त्री (पटना) : उपा-ध्यक्ष महोदय, बिहार की राजधानी पटना से सटा जलला क्षेत्र है, जहां बसे ग्रामों की संख्या 25-30 है। क्षेत्र की आबादी करीब एक लाख की है।

एक विकट समस्या वहां के किसानों को खेती के लिए कर्ज मुहैया करने की है। खाद ग्रादि के लिए बैंक की फतहा शाखा से कर्ज लेते हैं। परन्त, कर्ज प्राप्ति में उन्हें बेतरह परेशान होना पडता है। ग्रगर सौभाग्य से किसानों को कर्ज मिलता भी है, तो बैंक के ग्रधिकारियों को पांच रुपए प्रति सैंकडा नाजायज देना पड़ता है। इस प्रकार किसानों की खुली लूट हो रही है।

सरकार से मेरा अनुरोध होगा कि जल्ला क्षेत्र के किसानों की इस गम्भीर समस्या का समाधान तत्काल निकाले।

(vi) NON-AVAILABILITY OF NITROUS: OXIDE GAS AND OXYGEN GAS IN HOSPI-TALS OF UTTAR PRADESH.

SHRI HARIKESH BAHADUR rakhpur): It is a matter of grave concern that operations in Government hospitals have been stopped and patients are being removed due to non-availability of nitrous oxide gas and oxygen gas. This kind of notice has been put up on the notice board of Lucknow Medical College also. I urge upon the Central Government to look into the seriousness of the situation and make arrangements to provide requisites gases to the UP Government immediately so that the sufferings of the people may be avoided and operations may be started.

(vii) NEED FOR RATIONALISING THE SELEC-TION PROCEDURES IN BANK SERVICES.

SHRI N. SELVARAJU (Tiruchirapalli): Some years back, Banking Service Recruitment Boards were set up in various regions of the country and were entrusted with the job of recruiting officers and clerical staff for the natonalisec. banks. For selection of persons to the Officer Management Cadre in the banks, the basic requirement in regard to educational qualification is a graduate degree in any discipline from a recognised Indians The prospective candidates aspiring to join the nationalised banks

as Officers have to go through a long drawn and time consuming process by first appearing in a written test and thereafter placed on merit. The candidate is then required to appear before an interview board. Thus, as far as the procedure is concerned, it is not very much tifferent from that adopted by the Union 'ablic Service Commission.

However, in the interview more emphasis is placed on the knowledge displayed by the candidate in his field of study instead of the mental inclination and aptitude of the candidate. The Recruitment Board lays emphasis again even in the interview on oral academic proficiency. This is doing injustice to those who have performed well in the written examination and not fared well in the interview. Therefore, the benefit intended for the less fortunate ones do not materialise into reality.

Hence, I appeal for a more rational approach in the selection procedure, doing away with this practice.
