MR. SPEAKER: Hon'ble Members, I have to inform the House of the sad demise of Shri Sham Lal Saraf who was a Member of Third Lok Sabha from Jammu and Kashmir during 1962-67. Earlier he had been a Member of Jammu and Kashmir State Legislature from September, 1951 to April 1962. He was also a Minister in Jammu and Kashmir Government during 1947-62.

A businessman, he was associated with a number of social, cultural, educational and religious organisations.

Shri Saraf also took active part in the national movement.

An able parliamentarian, he took keen interest in the proceedings of the House. He also served on the Panel of Chairmen.

Shri Saraf passed away at Srinagar on 26th July, 1983, at the age of 79 years.
