

(xii) STOPPAGE OF PURCHASE OF JUTE BY J.C.I. RESULTING IN DISTRESS SALE OF JUTE BY GROWERS IN SOME PARTS OF BIHAR.

श्री इश्वर लाल बंडा (भररिया) : बिहार राज्य के पूर्णिया जिले खास कर भररिया, एनी गंज, फारबिस गंज तथा नरपत गंज प्रादि स्थानों में जे० सी० आई० तथा बिस्को-गान की धोर से जूट की खरीदगी बन्द कर दी गई है जिस से किसानों में हाहाकार मच गया है। अभी गेहूँ बोने के लिये बीज, खाद और पटसन के लिये किसानों को पैसों की आवश्यकता है। जूट की खरीदगी बन्द करने के कारण उन्हें लाचारी में कम दर पर (डिस्ट्रेस सेल) बिक्री करनी पड़ती है। प्रतः बाणिज्य मंत्री से अनुरोध किया जाता है कि वे अविलम्ब जे० सी० आई० एवम् बेस्कोमान को किसानों से जूट की खरीदगी रोकने के कारण उचित आदेश दें।
