Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING be pleased to state :

(a) the amount of ground rent and other dues outstanding against the owners of the Meridien and Bharat Hotels under construction in the capital ;

(b) the moratorium on payment granted to them from time to time and its expiry date ;

(c) whether the Raisina Road Hotel has encroached upon the pavement also ; if so, the extent of the land affected ;

(d) whether his Ministry proposes to permit the use of these Hotels for commercial purposes and how far this is being permitted in consonance with the terms of the allotment of land in both cases ; and

(e) how far the construction of these Hotels meant for Asian Games, 1982 is behind the schedule ?
