STATEMENT RE: ACCIDENT
AT AN UNMANNED LEVEL
CROSSING AT KOLANUR
(S.C. RAILWAY) IN VOLVING
JAYANTI JANATA EXPRESS AND
A BUS

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI P. C. SETHI) : Sir, I regret to apprise the House of an unfortunate accident which took place at an unmanned level crossing, kept normally closed by chain and padlock to road traffic and opened by station staff as and when required, situated at Kolanur station on Kazipet-Balharshah section of South Central Railway. On 20-3-1982, at about 13.20 hours a tourist bus which was carrying about 100 passengers entered the level crossing in the face of 131 Jayanti Janata Express which was running through the station, leading to a collision with the train. Due to the impact the bus was very badly damaged and the train engine was disabled.

As a result of the accident 60 bus passengers were killed and 33 sustained injuries.

On receipt of information medical van was rushed from Kazipet and it reached the site at 15.05 hours.
