SHRI KAMAL NATH: I have got the book here with me, and I have got a photostat copy of that page; I can lay* it on the Table of the House.

MR. SPEAKER: It seems, he is very knowledgeable person!

SHRI KAMAL NATH: He has taken the border right down to Allahabad. The Members from Allahabad must sit in a different House!

I am convinced that the hon. Members will agree with me that this is shameful callousness on the part of a man who once held the most powerful chair in the world. Richard Nixon apparently got so carried away by his blind 'tilt' Pakistan that he pushed the Indo-Pakistan boundary as far as Allahabad.

Such ignorance of a former President of the world's richest nation is an indication of Nixon's level of knowledge of our subcontinent and the general accuracy of his book. In the same chapter, Nixon sneers at Mrs Gandhi for being a "dictator". ... (Interruptions) Do agree?

Department for such delirious and absurd utterances from one of its former masters.
