ANNOUNCEMENT RE: REPORTS
OF SUB-COMMITTEE ON DEFENCE
OF THE ESTIMATES COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER. I have to inform the House that the Chairman of the Estimates Committee Shri Satyendra Narayan Sinha, has under proviso to clause (viii) (a) of Direction 101 of Directions by the Speaker has presented to me a copy each of the Reports of the Sub-Committee on Defence of the Estimates Committee on (i) Assessment of Potential Threat to India's Security and (ii) Modernisation of Defence-Navy. The Sub-Committee at their sittings held on 19thand 20th March, 1979, had approved these Reports. As in the view of the Sub-Committee, these Reports contain information of classified nature, the disclosure of which is likely to be prejudicial to national security, the Chairman has desired that these Reports may be treated as Secret and has also desired me to forward these reports to Government. I have accordingly forwarded these reports to the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Defence with a request that the action taken thereon may, in due course, be intimated to the Chairman, Estimates Committee.
