The State Government of Assam have been requested from time to time to look into the genuine grievances of tribals with promptness and sympathy. Five rounds of discussions involving Central Government and the Government of Assam and All Bodo Students' Union have already been held to find an amicable solution to the problems of plains tribals. A "Committee on Bodo Issues" has been set up to suggest solution to the problem. The Committee is required to submit its report in the next round of discussions scheduled to be held on 2.7.1990. The State Government have also been requested to consider giving more autonomy to the hill tribal areas under the Sixth Schedule.

## **Telegraph** Offices Functioning After Office Hours and on Closed Holidays

7387. SHRI PRATAPRAO B. BHOSALE: Will the Minister of COMMUNI-CATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) whether some Post offices and telegraph offices are functioning after office hours and even on closed holidays in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof state-wise and Union-Territory-wise and the categorisation of these offices;

(c) whether Government propose to set up such more offices in the country in next three years; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and if not the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI JANESHWAR MISHRA): (a) Yes, Sir. Post Offices, selected for their importance, are kept open after normal office hours and on holidays including Sundays There are 174 such Post Offices in the country. They are called Night Post Offices. All the telegraph offices work within the prescribed working hours on weekdays and closed holidays. Beyond the working hours, facility with late fee is made available based on requirement and feasibility.

(b) State-wise and Union Territory-wise locations where there are Night Post offices, are given in the statement below.

(c) While there is no definite plan for opening more Night Post Offices, wherever the facility is justified and financially viable, provision of the facility is part of the normal extension of service.

(d) In view of (c) above, does not arise.
