THE DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER AND MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND MINISTER OF TOURISM (SHRI DEVI LAL): (a) No, Sir. Tuberculosis in Tharparkar breed of cows at Central Cattle Breeding Farm, Suratgarh has been contained.

(b) Entire herd is tested periodically. Doubtful reactors to the first test are retested at intervals. Confirmed reactors are transferred to Gosadans of Rajasthan State.
