- (d) the total expenses borne by Government?

SHRI MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DE-VELOPMENT (SHRI CHIMANBHAI MEHTA): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) 1908 Indian artistes and a tew craftsmen participated in the Festival of India in the USSR. State-wise details of 1588 artistes are given below in a Statement-I. The remaining number drawn from many States of India were part of the closing events of the Festival.
- 521 artistes, including one craftsman participated in the Festival of India in France. A list of the groups which participated is given below in Statement-II. These artistes were also drawn from many of the States of India.
- (c) Under an Agreement with the recipient countries, expenditure on accommodation and food abroad, was the responsibility of the host country. However, expenditure on travel and remuneration for the 1588 artistes referred to in the reply to part (b) was Rs. 2,96,93,959.
- (d) The total expenditure on the Festival of India in France was Rs. 3.89 crores. The total expenditure on the Festival of India in the USSR was Rs. 14.48 crores.
