[Shri Annasahib Shinde]

Then, Sir, as far as the exports are concerned, Government is exploring the possibility as to whether some quantities could be exported outside. Beyond the quantities which we have agreed to export, it may be possible subject to the clearance by Finance and the assistance rendered by the Minister of Foreign Trade. We may succeed in exporting to a certain extent. I must say that as a result of the government policy, production has gone up and sugar availability is also more and there is no complaint of blackmarketing at the moment. I do not know what the hon. Member wants to know when he referred to the C. B. I. case. The pricing structure which is under discussion has been evolved on the basis of the recommendations of the Tariff Commission.
