(b) if so, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS (SHRI M.S. GURU-PADASWAMY): (a) and (b). Government had fixed the prices of natural gas for the first time in January 1987 in the following manner:

i)	Price of Onshore gas and Offshore gas at landfall points	— Rs. 1400/1000 M ³
ü)	Price of gas along the HBJ Pipeline	Rs. 2250/1000 M ^a
iii)	Price of gas in the North-Eastern Region.	— Rs. 1000/1000 M ³
		with a provision of discount upto Rs. 500/1000 M³

The above prices are exclusive of royalty, taxes and other local levies.

Concession in gas price for consumers in the North-Eastern Region had been given keeping in view the special development needs of the regions. The higher price of gas supplied through the HBJ Pipeline was fixed taking into consideration the transportation cost along the pipeline.

The prices are presently in force. A Committee headed by the Chairman, BICP has been set up to go into the issues of gas pricing. The report of the Committee is still awaited.

Setting up of Petrol-Diesel Pumps in Uttar Pradesh

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS (SHRI M.S. GURU-PADASWAMY): (a) and (b). As result of the surveys conducted, the locations namely Mau, Baberu and Manikpur in District Banda have been identified for setting up of petrol/ diesel retail outlets.

(c) In view of the various steps preceding commissioning of retail outlets, it is not possible to indicate when these retail outlets will be actually commissioned.

Prices of Khadi

*492. SHRI RAJVEER SINGH: Will the Minister of INDUSTRY be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government propose to bring down the prices of Khadi;

(b) the total amount allocated by Government for the development and production of khadi during 1990-91;

(c) whether Government propose to set up more khadi units; and

(d) if so, the State-wise details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF INDUSTRY (SHRI AJIT SINGH): (a) The price of khadi is fixed by the Central Certification Committee under KVIC by taking into account cost of inputs such as raw-material wages etc.

(b) An amount of Rs. 90 crores (Grant Rs. 50 crores and Loan Rs. 40 crores) has
