THE MINISTEROF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS (SHRI M.S. GURU-PADASWAMY): (a) Presently four onshore fields in Cauvery Basin viz. Narimanam, Adiyakkamangalam, Nannilam and Bhuvanagiri are under early production system. Development plans have been formulated for Narimanam and Adiyakkamangalam oil fields. Formulation of an integrated development plan for Cauvery Basin will depend upon the results of the delineation work for different structures as well as of the early production systems.

(b) The oil production from Cauvery Basin is expected to reach a level of 1 million tonnes per year the end of the eighth plan period, as against the present production level of 0.2 million tonnes per annum. It is not possible to quantify at this stage the employment opportunities for the local population, arising out of oil and gas development in the Cauvery Basin.

## Joint Ventures with Hungary for Production of Maruti Spare Parts
