- (e) the action plan drawn up for wasteland development for the remaining period of Seventh Five Year Plan in Gujarat; and
- (f) the amount allocated for the purpose?

THE MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRIBHAJAN LAL): (a) to (d). Wasteland Development in Gujarat is carried out under the Centrally sponsored Schemes, and State Plan Schemes including Externally Aided Social Forestry Project. In addition, propoals for assistance are received from Voluntary and Non-Government Organisations. Details are given in Statement - I and II below.

(e) and (f). The Action Plan is prepared on year-to-year basis. The physical target of Wasteland Development for 1987-88 is 1,50,000 ha. and Rs. 28.42 crores have been allocated.
