(a) to (c). Oil and natural Gas Commision has been following the instructions of Government with regard to giving preference in employment to persons whose land has been acquired. In Gujarat during the last three years employment has been given to 59 such persons.

## Rise in Price of Plastics

The international prices of plastics have gone up by more than 50 per cent during the last one year. The uptrend in international prices continues.
